

INTERESTED IN BIOMEDICAL INFORMATICS?

Since 2011, the Division of Biomedical Informatics (DBMI) at the University of California San Diego has organized an annual 8 - 12 week summer Biomedical Informatics internship program that included students at the high school and college levels (graduate and post-graduate levels).

For 2024, DBMI is excited to launch paid summer internship programs in Data Science and Biomedical Informatics. The experience combines didactic material with project-based learning led by faculty mentors. At the conclusion of the internships, teams will present projects at an annual symposium.

PAID INTERNSHIPS WILL BE OPEN TO:

Undergraduate, graduate and professional school students who are at least 18 years of age, currently enrolled or employed at a university or other research institution

Spots are available on a limited basis and contingent upon funding

Some funding sources may require that the intern be a U.S. citizenship, legal resident, or that they be allowed to work in the U.S.

Students from under-represented populations are encouraged to apply.

Interns are expected to be available 40 hours/week; time off from the internship may not be available
